CHANG Chien-man, chairman of the Hong Kong-Mowloon General Mabor Union, has it med instructions to the leaders of all pro-Communist unions to organize immediately within their unions a special corps consisting of at least 100 men. These men are to be chosen on a basis of their education and physical

qualifications. Each of these special corps will undergo training in subjects such as ideals and aims of a Communist Government; propaganda; public speaking; and fundamentals in the care, maintenance, and use of arms.

- 3. A special fund has been established by the union to which every member must contribute. It is earmarked for the military rehabilitation of a New China.
- 4. A Volunteer Corps has been organized by the unions to help union members wishing to join the Communist Army. The Corps guarantees that the training and skills of the recruits will be used by the army, and they will not be automatically sent into the infantry.
- 5. On 1 October 1949, a secret memorandum was issued to all union chairmen, stating that the union will back up any demand for increased wages provided one-half of the increased gained is contributed to the union.
- 6. On 5 November 1949, the Chinese Doctors Union at its annual meeting had serious disputes over the future aims of the union. One group insisted that, as doctors, their task is to remain neutral and heal the sick. As Communist members are both numerous and powerful in this union, it may not be able to pursue its impartial political policy.
- 7. Although the unions are dominated by Communist chairmen and committee members, not all members are pro-Communist. The members are generally satisfied with working conditions in Hong Kong, and are not in favor of subscribing to increased union dues. Whatever their inclinations, members abide by decisions of their union leaders, as they want to avoid Communist persecutions. In general, they are willing to belong to a Communist union as long as they are not in Communist territory.
