POTSDAM

SUBJECT: Reconstruction and Expansion of the COHOENFELD Airfield.*

In compliance with Order No. 116, dated 16 May 1947, and issued by the Supreme Chief of the Soviet Military Administration for Germany I herewith give the following orders:

1. To the Minister resident of the Province of Brandenburg, Dr. STEINHOFF:**
 - a. A special construction bureau will be established by 25 May 1947 for the execution of the designing and construction in connection with the expansion of the airfield;
 - b. The necessary labor will be provided according to the requirements of the construction bureau;
 - c. The reconstruction and expansion work will be executed in conformity with the work plan attached as Annex 1 and will be completed by 1 December 1947 at the latest.
2. The German technical personnel and workers directly employed for the execution of the construction work will be granted rations according to the norms for workers of the first category valid in BERLIN; the technical personnel and workers will be granted, on working days, additional food allowances according to the norms laid down in Annex 2, and as an incentive for their efficiency special grants of tobacco will be made available.
3. To the Chief of the Agriculture Division, Gds Lt Col TROYANOV, that he carry out the requisitioning of the portions of land to be added to the airfield in conformity with the construction plans against a corresponding compensation of the owners concerned by assignment of one hundred acres of land to be placed to the account "Land" of the UTDP (?) Division of the Group of the Soviet Occupation Troops in Germany.
