1. Villa Schiller, which was once used by the King of Yugoslavia, is located on the coast about one-half kilometer north of Mestrovic Villa, in Split. It was used during the war by the Germans as a special rest resort for high ranking officers. From 1945 to 1947 it was made into an orphanage.
2. Once vacated, the Villa was completely renovated and currently is being used to house high-ranking Yugoslav officials. For their protection, a military barracks has been constructed immediately north of the Villa. Tito is known to have visited there.
