19 - Oil reservoirs and refineries. The area was enclosed by a brick wall about two meters high.

20 - Oil tanks damaged by Allied bembing during the war. The damage was not considerable and the tanks were being repaired.

21 - Locemotive depot, capable of accommodating 10 to 12 locemotives. This was a brick construction covered with white corrugated sheet metal.

23 - Electric power station preducing current for the port

2h - Warehouses.

25 - Harbornaster's office.

26 - Shippards. Three or four ships sunk during the war and subsequently salvaged were undergoing repairs.

27 - Wharves.

28 - Large breakwater

29 - Eavigation lights at the port entrance.

30 - Breakwater light

31 - Two small breakwaters. Since early 1948 work has been carried out to extend these breakwaters. Concrete blocks

> were used in this construction. One was to be extended to a length of 100 to 150 meters, the other to a length of 50 to 60 meters wide and 2 to 25 meters. Both will be about 4 meters wide and 2 to 25 meters above see level.

32 - Small harbor used as anchorage for fishing craft.

33 - Old breakwater

34 - At this location dredgers were seen operating in early 1945.

35 - Barracks. On the seaward side of the barracks two or three guns were located on fixed h0 - Buildings occupied by an unspecified Soviet unit.

h1 - Barracks occupied by an unspecified Soviet unit.

h2 - Central telephone exchange.

hj - Pest, telegraph and telephone building.

kh - Greek school.

45 - Greek Orthodox Church.

k6 - Buildings belonging to the Breek community.

k7 - Railway etation.

hs - Single storey brick building which was used as a Rumanian military club.

by - Small buildings and sheds used by Rumanian railway guards.

50 - Areal administration offices.

51 - Soviet Consulate Coneral.

52 - Market place.

53 - Public hospital. This was a she-storey building.

5h - Soviet military stores. These were two large two-storey buildings previously used as grain warehouses.

55 - Offices of the General Workers Confederation.

56 - Offices of the Greek Communist Party

57-Carlton hetel. This was the largest hotel in Constants and was occupied by Soviet efficers.

58- Offices of the Social Insurance.

59- Former kirces Lyceum, occupied by an unspecified
Soviet unit. Officers were ebserved instructing units in map reading.

60. Military hespital. It was not known whether the hospital was used by Soviet or Rumanian forces.

61. Three buildings occupied by the Rumanian security services.

62- Civil prison. This was the former shore restaurant center known as Tataia.

63- Old civil prison. This was still in use.

by - An unspecified number of guns located here.

65 -Barracks occupied by an . unspecified Soviet unit.

66 - Russnian church.

67- Slaughter house.

68- Town electric power station.

69- Village of Hamaia. This village was completely occupied by the Seviets.

70- Mamaia beach. The public was allowed to use this beach only occasionally.
