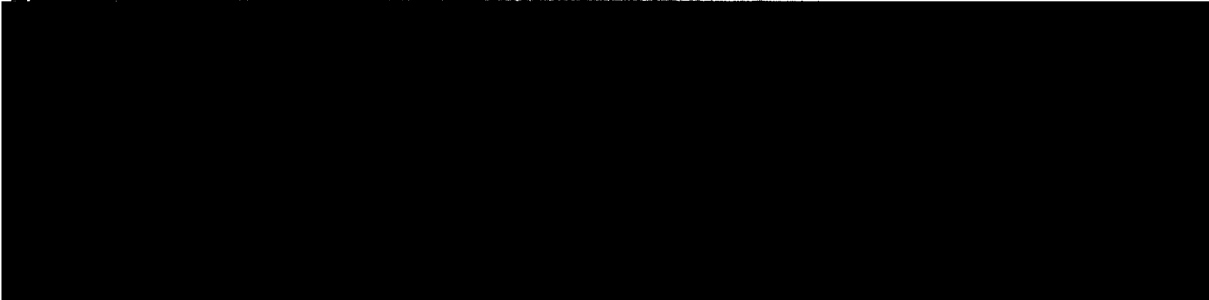

 - b. On 13 March LIANG Kuang (梁康) and CHANG Wen (張文), chief of the Special Service Section of the South China Bureau to Kukong.
 - c. On 14 March LI Chang-ta (李章達) Deputy Governor of Kwangtung, to Tungkuan (113-46, 23-02).
