In early February 1950 Prince Te sent two representatives to Ninghsia to discuss a rapprochement with the local Chinese Communist authorities.\* At the end of February, one representative had returned to Prince Te, while the other, Giljintai\*\*, remained in Ninghsia.

\* [REDACTED] Comment. Prince Te is doubtless in desperate circumstances which force him to resort to this means to reduce the pressure on him.

[REDACTED] Comment. If Prince Te had reached a full accord with the Chinese Communists, the latter would certainly have given the fact wide publicity. It appears probable that Prince Te is seeking a local tactical advantage.
