The motorized sailing vessels referred to in reference () which arrived at Durres on 3 March, are not in regular service. They reportedly unloaded about 700 tons of cork, and loaded about 580 tons of scrap-iron originating from sunken merchant ships and scrap oil barrels. According to source, the line will operate as long as the scrap material lasts.

2. With regard to the wooden barges (sie) of Shengjin, those have been in service since April 1949; as for the barracks referred to in reference, these are actually used as billets for troops who carry out coastal surveillance duties to prevent the infiltration of agents coming from Corfu.
