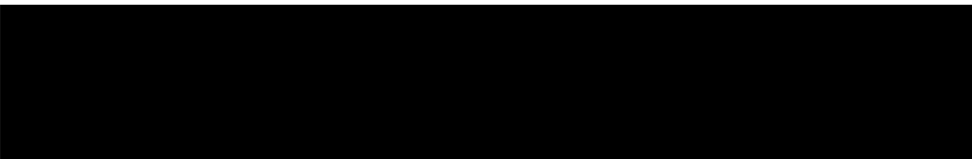

An anti-American and anti-Buddhist article which appeared in Mahachon is believed to have been written by Samruat Kanchanasit*, former aide to Rear Admiral Taharn Khamiran** and presently a Flight Lieutenant in the Thai Air Force. Although Samruat has written other pro-Communist articles, this is the first piece he has written for Mahachon. The Mahachon article was written under the pen name of "The Spirit of Bang Prachung Camp***." Samruat's authorship of the article is indicated by several pertinent references to the Thai Navy Commander-in-Chief, Vice Admiral Sindhu Kamonnawin.
