- HU Tz'u-wei (胡汉氏) also known as CHANG Ch'ing (長清), who until 1946 was a provincial official in Szechuan, is a fellow provincial and long-time trusted friend of CHEN II. HU is now living in Shanghai in retirement. He is still on excellent terms with CHAN, who relies upon MU to a very great extent for advice. Hu is acceptable to Communists and to non-Communists.
- 2. IIU is a lawyer who received his training in Japan. At one time he was a professor at the Central Folitical Institute in Nanking, a Kuomintang indoctrination school.
- 3. As commissioner for Civil Affairs in Szechuanand Hunan, HU was instrumental in making arrangements for the supply of labor and materials for the construction of airfields for the United States during the war. His final post in the Lationalist Government was Vice Linister of the Interior.
