1. The Chinese Communist Ch'ung Yai Column (瓊崖) in Hainan has an approximate strength of 17,500. Its leaders are commander FENG Pai-chu (馮白駒), political commissars WU K'e-chih* (吳克之) and MA Pai-shan* (馬白山), and chief of staff FU Chih-chien (符志堅).*
2. Commanders, strength, and disposition of units under its command are as follows:
 - a. 1 Division, 2,500 men, active in eastern Hainan in the area between Wenchang Hsien (110-42, 19-42) and Chia Ting (加定); commander WU K'e-chih.
 - b. 2 Division, 2,500 men, active in the general area of Nanfeng (109-31, 19-26) west of Chengmai Hsien (109-58, 19-47) and south of Linkao (109-43, 19-56); commander, FU Ch'i-lo (符其洛).*
 - c. 3 Division, 3,700 men, active in the area northwest of Lohui Hsien (110-27, 19-13); commander CH'EN Kuang-ch'iu (陳光球). It lost some men near Lun Pu Shih (崙布士).
 - d. 4 Division, 2,500 men, between Paoting (109-32, 18-40) and Tengchiao (109-43, 19-23); commander, CHANG Kuo-t'ai (張國泰).
 - e. 5 Division, 2,500 men, active in the general area of Changchien (108-45, 19-16) and Kuang Ch'ang (廣場); commander, CH'EN Wu-ying (陳武英). It lost about two hundred men at Yingkotsui (108-42, 18-31).
 - f. Special Service Regiment, 700 men, in the general area of Wuchihshan (109-27, 18-52) and Lotung (109-10, 18-54); commander, CH'IU Yueh-shih (丘岳士). It lost over a hundred men near Wengtien (110-55, 19-57).
 - g. Independent Regiment, 700 men, active near Wengtien, northeast of Wenchang and Ch'ang P'u (昌浦), and south of Ch'ung Shan (瓊山); commander, LIANG Chung-ming (梁仲明).

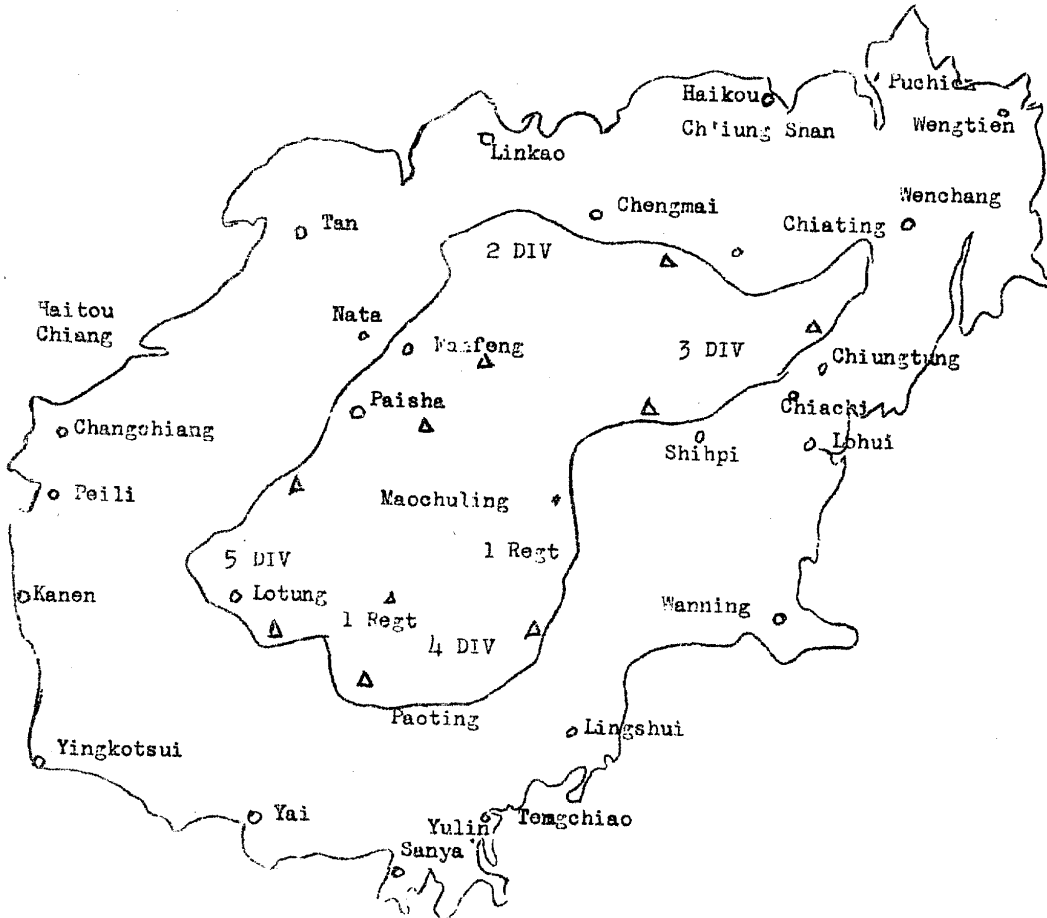
