The following information was obtained on soviet troops in Stockerau (O 49/3 21):

- 1. Prinz Eugen Kaserne:
 - a. One hundred and ten troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets held rifle-drill on the drill ground behind the kaserne (still in the kaserne area).
 - b. Four light AA guns on four-wheel mounts were parked between the buildings. Two of the guns had protective shields.

- 2. Jaeger and Artillerie Kaserne:
 - a. The radio station in the kaserne yard was not in operation. Only a few soldiers (red-bordered black epaulets) were seen.
