- d. The 4 Regiment, in the 3, 4 and 6 Districts. The 6 Company of the 3 Battalion of this regiment is at Tahengchin (113-30, 22-08).

  - a. The Chungshan Independent Regiment. The 1 Company of the 1 Battalion of this regiment is at Tsuiwei, north of Chienshan.
  - b. The 3 Artillery Regiment, with the 7 Battery on Santsao (113-22, 22-05).
- 5. Each battalion has 3 companies of infantry in addition to 1 section of artillery and a total of 70-80 officers and men.
- 6. The 1 Regiment of the Kwangtung-Fukien Border (KFB) Column, formerly at Chienwu, was recently, ordered to Canton. Many troops have deserted from the 4 Sub-Column of the KFB Column under TSENG Tien-chieh (曾天節) which was formerly at Hengmen and Chiao.
- 7. The KK Column and the KFB Column will be merged into a river defense command of the provincial defense army comprising one corps and three columns under TSENG and WANG.
- 8. Communist troops on Tahengchin and Santsao include two infantry regiments of the 130 and 131 Divisions and one artillery battalion of the 144 Division.
