- 1. [Redacted] Titov, Soviet vice consul from Tientsin, was in Tsingtao in connection with extending the passports of Soviet subjects.
- 2. More than a thousand Soviet pilots and technicians were living at airfields in the Tsingtao area [Redacted] Only four or five of them have visited the city, always accompanied by Chinese officials.
- 3. [Redacted] two twin-motored planes were practicing regularly over Tsingtao.
