1. The following aircraft were observed at the Wiener-Neustadt (Q 48/X 35) airfield:

Ten twin-engine DC-3 transport airplanes (counted); thirty-two PE-2s (counted); forty-five single-engine fighters (estimated) and two single-engine biplanes.

2. There was no flying between 9 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

3. There was a telephone line between the Nachrichten Kaserne on Pernersdorferstrasse and the airfield. 50X1-HUM

4. [redacted] trucks were parked in two garages of the Kaserne [redacted]

Comment:

a. A regiment of the 9th Gds Ftr Div and an unidentified transport squadron equipped with LI-2s have been believed to be stationed at the Wiener-Neustadt airfield. The fighter regiment was confirmed [redacted]. The two other regiments of the division and the division headquarters are stationed in Trausdorf. 50X1-HUM

b. The location of a bomber unit (PE-2 aircraft) at the Wiener-Neustadt airfield was reported for the first time. Correctness of the information cannot be judged.
