1. The Strasshof (P 49/S 50) airfield was occupied by 4 single-engine biplanes and about 110 twin-engine Pe-2s on 26 January 1950.
2.
  - a. About 65 Pe-2s were parked at the field on 20 February 1950. Intensive servicing work was being done on the parked planes. 50X1-HUM
  - b. Truck [redacted] and ambulance [redacted] were seen near the dispensary not far from the Strasshof railroad station. A physician ranking as lieutenant colonel left the building. 50X1-HUM
  - c. Twenty-four Soviet Air Force second lieutenants were sitting in front of the officers' villas. An air force colonel (highest rank seen there) left another air force quarters. He went by passenger car [redacted] in the direction of Deutsch Wagram (P 49/S 50) 50X1-HUM
  - d. Trucks [redacted] equipped for the transportation of troops were seen in Strasshof. Tank truck [redacted] and trucks [redacted] were noticed in the motor vehicle park southeast of Deutsch Wagram. 50X1-HUM
