1. Shortly before the middle of April 1950 three reporters of the Chu Chiang (Pearl River) Jen min Pao (珠江人民報) arrived in Shihchi (113-22, 22-30). They are CHENG wei-ch'ing (鄭貴清), MA Liang (馬良) and CHENG wei-yuan (鄭貴源).
2. The manager of the Jou Lin Pao in Macao is OU Ch'eng-shou (歐澄守). He has his office at the New Life Cafe on October Fifth Street, first floor, Macao. He and the reporters are working for the Chinese Communists.
