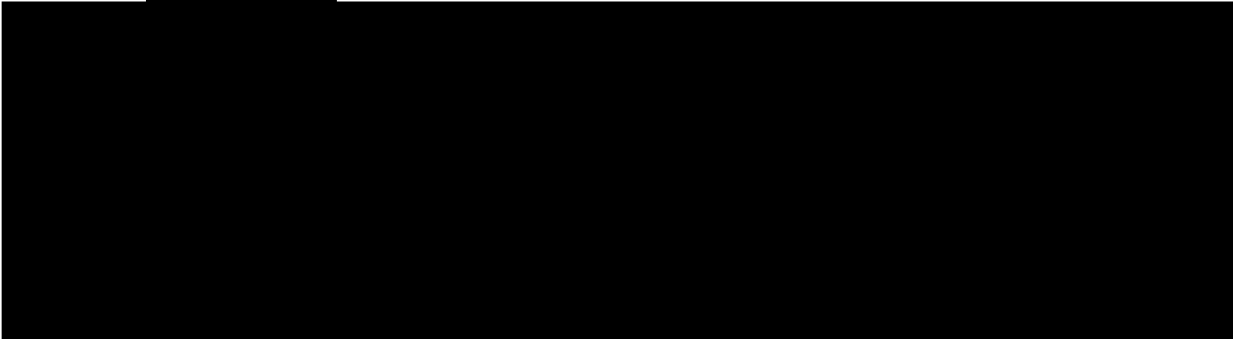

1. The air force troops stationed at Sonkyo-ri (approximately 125-45, 38-58) near Pyongyang, received on 2 March a shipment of 38 carloads of materiel. This was the largest shipment received in 1950. The freight cars came from Najin (130-15, 42-10) but they and their contents were believed by Sonkyo-ri troops to have originated in the USSR.
2. The shipment included the following:
 - 20 carloads of aluminum plate and ingots, brass ingots, pistons and piston rings, nickel, red copper pipe, aluminum pipe, various metals, and second-hand precision lathes of German manufacture.
 - 15 carloads of aviation gasoline.
 - 3 carloads of aviation oil.
