In April 1950 Prince Te and a force of about five thousand were in the area near the Kansu Corridor continuing their guerrilla activity. Prince Te has followed a policy of not molesting the local inhabitants and consequently enjoys their sympathy and support. The food ration for members of his group is now four ounces of meat per man per day.
