

- 1. On 15 Larch 1950 W hsing (吳 崖 ), a fa T'ien Erh\* leader from F'ing Ch'ung (油 涌) in eastern Chungshan hsien, arrived in macao with ten followers. In april, no was staying with a friend on the ground floor of 9 Yeh hu Ch'ien (夜母前街) Street. He and his followers were collecting money, in the name of the min Sheng (元 生 ) Company, from river boats at Chu Chou T'ou ( T ) [ ] , near Ch'ien Shan (113-32, 22-14) on the inlet west of Macao. The area of activity of the group these mon represent is from P'ing Ch'ung to Chu Chou T'ou. The organization, which consists of 100 men with 5 or 6 machine guns, is under the leadership of WU Chauaa (吳全). before coming to macao, the men who accompanied WU haing were engaged in carrying information between the field group and the macao leader, traveling as smugglers on wood rafts between macao and P'ing Ch'ung.
- 2. In early April 1950 river boats calling at Macao were receiving threatening letters, demanding money, signed by HO Feng (何峰) and CHOU Ch'un (周春), director and deputy director respectively of the Ssu I Ch'ing Lien She (四色青藤社) >\* The letters instructed the recipients to deliver the money to the offices of the various Ch'ing Lien She in
- 3. River boats in macao have received notices asking for contributions of foodstuffs for the 3 Army of the Awangtung Provincial Anti-Communist Mational Salvation Army\*\*\*, signed by MUALC Chao (黃朝), commander of the & Regiment, 3 Army, Awangtung Provincial Anti-Communist Astional Selvation Army.\*\*\*\* EUALG has an office, snown as the Hung Chi (消息) Company, on the ground floor of the T'ai An (秦 安) Hotel, Hai Pang (海傍) Street, macao, which is used as a center for the collection of money from various shipping companies. In early April, EUANG Chao, who is also known as HUANG Mien (黃耳), was appointed to command a regiment in the 9 Livision, 3 Army, Anti-Communist Mational Salvation Army. Le is a native of Miu Wan (牛海) in Mainhui haien. In Macao, HUANG resides at the Muchow Hotel. HUALG resides at the Wuchow hotel.

- 4. On 7 April 1950 Ll Chiu (李 九), an officer of the Chiu Lung (九 龍) Company of the 5th district of Chungshan Lsien, arrived in macao and began demanding protection fees from shipping firms. The same activity was also being carried on by FU Lua-shan (得 華 山), also known as Fu Ch'ing-lung (停 青龍), who also arrived in macao on 7 April 1950.
- 5. On 28 march 1950 more than forty armed men, part of the forces of the Chinese Nationalist Ministry of National Defense, raided a Communist grain boat at Pai Sha Lan ( 17 ), opposite Malau Chau, an island about ten miles southwest of Macao, and took more than forty piculs of grain.
