SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

A group of fifty French scientists, headed by Frederic Joliot-Curie, former chief of the French Atomic Energy Commission, will leave on 15 June 1950 for a visit to the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. France-URSS, a Communist front organization, is sponsoring the trip. Most of the group are chemists and the purpose of the trip is reportedly to impress French scientists with the progress being made by the Soviets in science and in chemistry in particular.
