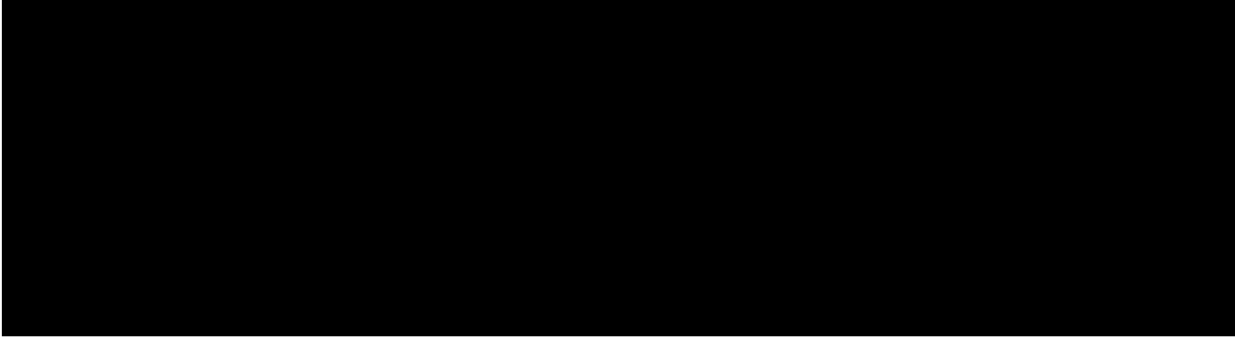

- 25X1X 1. [redacted] although there were no Soviet soldiers in Turnu Severin, a "great number" of them were massed further up the Danube River on the Yugoslav border.
- 2. The city of Craiova appeared to have more Militia and uniformed members of the Securitate than he had observed anywhere else. He stated that "the streets were full" of Militia.
- 25X1X 3. [redacted] almost all the jobs in state enterprises and the administration of Turnu Severin were now occupied by militant Communists who had been sent to Turnu Severin from elsewhere in Rumania.
