- Maruto Nitimihardjo is a Communist and a rationalist and a close follower of Tan Balaka. He is influential among the members of the Partai hakjat and the Partai Murba. He makes excellent speeches in the Komite Nasional Indonesia Pusat at Jogjakerta and in the Representative Assembly at Djakarta. The Djakarta branch of the Partai Murba was recently inaugurated at his suggestion.
- Sjamsu Harja Udaja recently stated in Somerang that Ten Melaka died in rural Kediri in February 1949. Col. Sungkono ordered him to be shot because he refused to stop agitating the peasants in East Java. The man who was recently seen in Meden who looked like Tan Malaka is a double of Tan's according to Udaja. This man came from Bandjermasin.
- Sukarni, when questioned on the subject, said that the Partai Eurba is neither Stalinist nor Trotskyist, but is Indonesian netionalist Communist. He said it differed in a few principles from other proleterian parties in Indonesia. Sukarni stated that Soviet kussia championed labor's cause.
- Udaja claims the party has 500,000 members throughout Indonesia.
