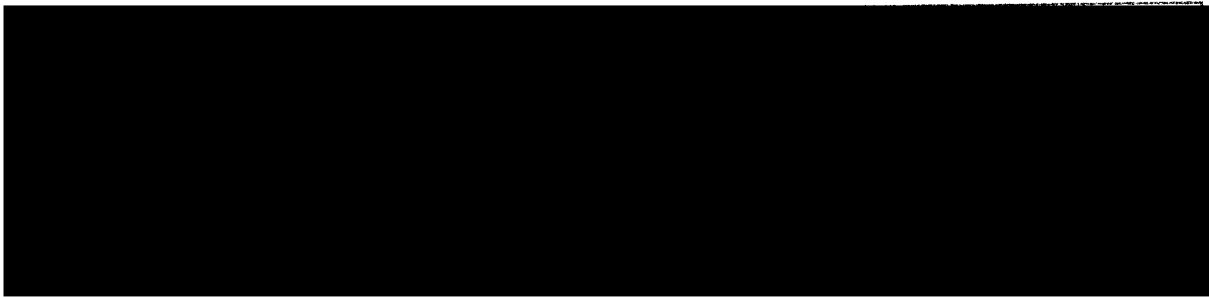

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO. 25X1X



1. The internal organization of the Communist Party of Chile (PCCh) on the cell level has been recently changed. The street cells are apparently to disappear and be replaced by commercial and factory cells. Communist leaders believe this will allow for more effective control of the laboring classes and increased solidarity among them.
2. Furthermore, it has been reported that the Executive Committee of the Party is anxious to replace many of the present cell leaders with new individuals. During recent changes in Party leadership, it has been noted that Volodir Teitelboim Volosky, member of the Central Committee, has gained considerable prestige within the Party where he is regarded as the most probable successor to Gale Gonzalez, present head of the Party, in the event that the latter should for one reason or another be removed from his position.
3. There is a group of old-time leaders in the Party who believe that proletarian revolution can not succeed in one country alone. They believe that the Communists' principal efforts should be directed toward the gradual destruction of national political parties which might be expected to cooperate with imperialistic, economic interests and serve as a base for national reaction against Communist-led mass uprisings. They stress the importance of Communist-inspired solidarity among South American workers.
4. The Communist leaders have recently emphasized the development and integration of Communist intellectuals with the Party's programs. Previously, the intellectuals had been considered of minor importance, but the influence of French, Italian, British and Russian Communist intellectual groups in their national Parties has created renewed interest in Chile in the value of collaboration between the workers and the intellectual elements.
