4. Additional data on aircraft types:
  - a. The observed Trabant (parasite) painted blue or red is probably not identical to the single-engine jet fighter. It was particularly noticed that the fuselage was pointed and that this craft had no rudder assembly. Trabant type aircraft were not seen before June 1949. After the take-off the plane, plus parasite, flew two or three circles and then turned off in an unknown direction. Such a plane was noticed three times every week; it would return after about 20 minutes. It would always land with the parasite.
  - b. The twin-engine fighter was first seen in May 1948. It definitely was not a three-engine plane. A dark body, looking like an opening, was noticed at the nose. [Redacted] it was some sort of glazing.

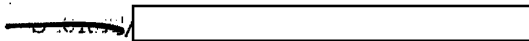
