- In response to May Day proclemations issued in Perping, two organisations have been formed in Macao, both advocating the abolition of foreign control in Hong Kong, Kowloon and Macao. Since the two groups, acting independently, have been attempting to obtain a favored position with the Chinese Communist Party, friction has developed between them.*
- 2. One of these groups, the Macac Branch Commission for retaking Hong Kong, Rowloon and Macao, functions under the direction of the Chinese Communist special commissioner for Macao.** Members of the Overseas Chinese Associakion form the nucleus of this group.
