

- 1. The principal airfields in the vicinity of Constants are the Constants airport which is operated by TARS (Transporturi Acriene Romano - Sovietice-Rumanian-Soviet Air Transport), the scaplane base at the lake of Siut Chiol, the military field at Manain Sat, and the military field at Ciccarlia de Jos.
- 2. The last mentioned field is near the village of Ciccarlia de Jos, about six kilometers from Cobadin, and about 33 to 38 kilometers from Constanta by rail. This field is the largest and most active in the Constants area. It is equipped to service 200 aircraft, has underground warehouses, and gasoline at about 5:00 a.m., 40 to 50 Soviet aircraft passed over Constanta and were believed to have landed at Ciocarlia de Jose These were not fighters but were believed to be two motor cargo planes of the Douglas type.
- 3. There has been an increase in the number of Soviet air personnel in the city of Constanta, and this personnel is believed to be stationed at Ciocarlia de Jos. Among them are several high ranking officers including one General who lives at the house at the intersection of Decebal and Major Giurescu streets. The house is guarded by two Soviet soldiers.
