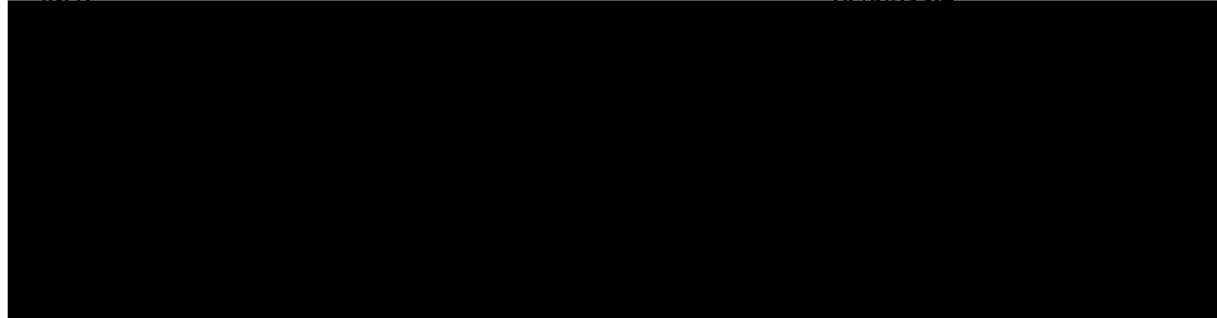

1. A circular letter by the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Austria which was to be sent to all district boards in all of Austria.
2. In this letter each district board was ordered to establish groups of 20 to 25 men which were to attract public attention by staging minor disturbances. These groups are to be active at demonstrations against increased rents, etc. Juveniles must not be used for this purpose and no window panes must be damaged. The police must not be provoked in the Western Zones of Austria, but stronger action may be taken in the Soviet Zone of Austria, where the Soviets promised to give support.
