1. In compensation for the military aid it is receiving from the USSR, the North Korean government has been sending railroad materials to the USSR.\* In July 1919, the Soviet army removed one line of the double track between Kassong (126-34, 37-58) and Sinuiju (124-24, 40-06). In February 1950, they also

removed all steel bridges along the line and transported them to the USSR.

Beginning 15 February 1950, one of the two steel bridges over the Chang-chon (清 川) River at Anju (125-40, 39-36), South Pyongan Province, was removed for transportation to the USSR. Labor from the village was mobilized to effect the removal.


