The Soviet military supervisor assigned to the Cottbus (N 52/A 57) Railroad District Administration, issued an order on 20 March 1950 that an exhaustive report be rendered on all loading ramps in the railroad district, including information on size, measurements, loading capacity, end-loading ramp, approach tracks, and departure roads. The report requested is not routine.
