- 1. The operational status of airfields in Human as of 1 June 1950 are as follows:
 - a. The Changeha airfield located north of the city is in good condition. It has a staff of 60 men and is occasionally used by transports. The field is a prohibited area and was inspected by the Soviets in March
 - b. The Kiengton (112-51, 27-54) a rfield, unused since 1945, is in need of major repairs.
 - c. The Hengyang (112-35, 26-56) airfield, a heavily guarded erea, was repaired in February 1950. The field is occasionally used by transports and 5,000 drums of gasoline are stored there. The Soviets have made an inspection of the field.
 - d. The Communists are contemplating the repair of Pin Hsien () airfield, unused since 1945. A detachment of 300 laborers of the Wu Kung Tui (武功豫) is stationed there.
 - The Shaoyang (111-23, 27-15) airfield is occasionally used by transports and 300 drums of aviation gasoline are stationed there. One regiment of the 138 Division is stationed there.
 - f. The Changte (111-32, 29-02) airfield is imperable.
 - g. The Chihchiang (109-37, 27-27) airfield, occasionally used by transports, was inspected by the Soviets in April 1950. One regiment of the 136 Division, 47 Army is stationed there.
- 2. There are no tactical aircraft stationed on any of the airfields in Human and Soviet personnel are believed to be stationed only at Hengyang.
