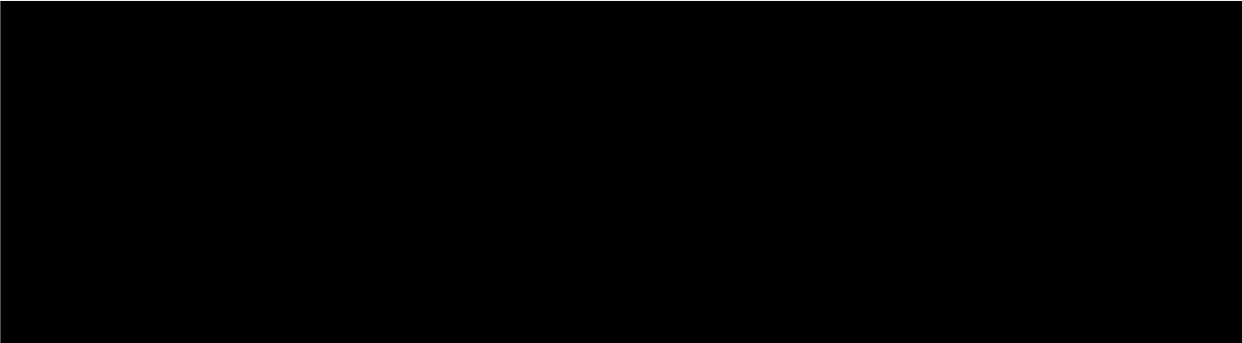

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO. 25X1A



1. LI Li-ming (李立名), head of the Foreign Affairs Section of the Kongmoon Military Control Commission (MCC), arrived in Macao on 22 April 1950. Between 22 April and 27 April 1950, he and HSIEN Teai-sheng (謝再生), CH'EN Chih-sheng (陳植生)*, HUANG Yung (黃榮)**, KUO Ch'ing-ch'uan (郭清泉) and other high-ranking officials of the Canton MCC held a conference at the Hsing Kuang Book Store (星光書店). first floor. At this series of meetings the decision was reached to control the movements of the vehicles of the Chih Kuan Bus Company and of steamers traveling between Macao and Communist-controlled areas. It was also proposed to subject to strict inspection travelers between Chienshan, just north of Macao, and Wanchai, west of Macao, and Communist areas. The detailed regulations for implementing these controls were to be promulgated by the Canton MCC.***
2. The group also discussed the collection of information on Kuomintang property in Canton and the sale of victory bonds.

25X1A Comment. It is probable that he is the CH'EN Chih-sheng reported in [redacted] despite the difference in the second character.

25X1X Comment. In April HUANG was on the staff of the garrison section of a Chinese Communist unit in Macao.

25X1A*** Comment. The plans for Macao reported in [redacted] were apparently the ones formulated at this meeting.
