 - a) An article by LIM Hong Bee *, described as a Malayan Youth Delegate. The article was contributed on behalf of the Malayan New Democratic Youth League and is addressed to "Democratic Youth in Colonial and Imperial Countries who are struggling against exploitation. T eulogizes the USSR and its satellites, including the German Democratic Republic and the Chinese Communist Government.
 - b) Another article, unsigned, condemns the constitution of the Republik Indonesia Serikat, asserting that the Hague Round Table Conference was influenced by the US. It states also that Indonesia is a colony of the US and the Netherlands and that Indonesia's vice president and prime minister, Mohammed Hatta, is an agent of foreign powers.
 - c) An article on the Peiping conference of the World Federation of Trade Unions (WFTU) speaks of Veerasenan ** and S.A. Ganapathy ** as victims of imperialist terrorism in Malaya.
