One mission was to arrange for the passage of the couriers of the Barzanis through Iran from the USSR to Iraq.

2. Fattah Agha, chief of the Sarhad subtribe of the Herki Kurds, arrived in Ushnuiyeh (NS7°02" E45°07"), Iran, during the week ending 3 July. He is reported to have told "many" that Iranian Kurds should support future passage of the Barsanis. There is no indication of the date of such a passage

- 3. Sometime during the period 22 June to 3 July Iraq reinforced its border guards along the Iran-Iraq frontier, southwest of Rezaieh.
