Kruglev, a recent arrival in Vienna, has been named Soviet director of Juschingsthtrans but as yet no one has taken over Lasutin's former post. - 4. In the past four to five weeks Juschwneschtrans has handled an estimated 3,000 tons of sugar which USIA has imported duty free from Czechoslovakia and Hungary. Although these shipments were consigned to USIA's Central Commercial Bureau, USIA's Food Industry Administration, and to the "Arbeiterversorgung" (provisions for USIA employees), Austrian employees of Juschwneschtrans believe the Soviets may plan to sell most of this sugar on the Austrian market to obtain schillings.
- 5. During the same period USIA's Central Commercial Bureau has imported large quantities of textiles from Czechcslovakia and Switzerland for "Letex" Einund Verkaufszentrale der vereinigten Leder- und Textilbetriebe, Vienna IV. During the first two weeks of May 1950 approximately 30 tons of yarn, cloth, stockings, and finished garments arrived in Vienna. It is believed that USIA intends to sell these textiles on the Austrian market through non-USIA firms.
