- There was fair weather but no flying at the Doeberitz (N 53/Z 65) airfield between 10 and 11 a.m. The doors of the hangars were closed. About 25 ground attack aircraft stood on the southern edge of the field and from 50 to 60 planes of the same type on the northern edge. The planes were parked in rows and had their numbers painted on the rudder assembly or on the fuselage. The rudder assemblies of some planes had a red leading edge. There were bombs in wooden crates beside some aircraft. *

* [REDACTED] Comment. Report confirms occupation of the airfield by ground attack aircraft. Two ground attack regiments are assumed to be stationed in Doeberitz.
