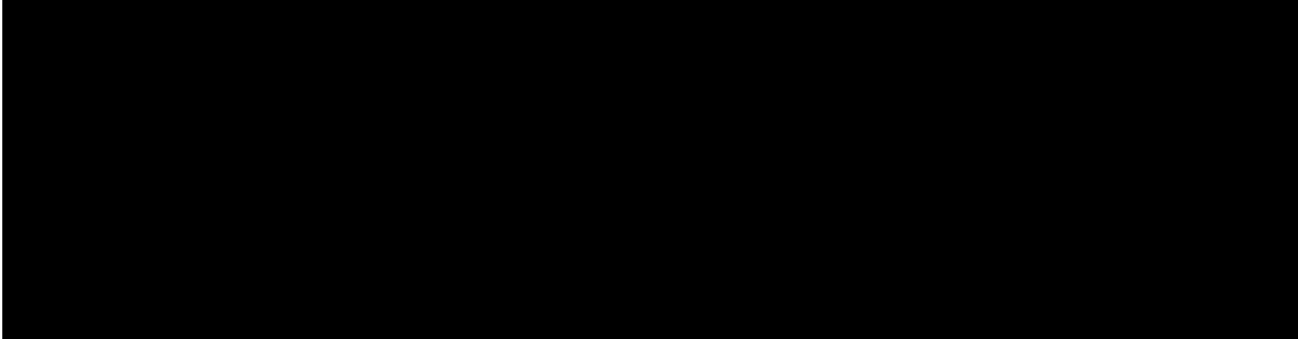

1. An infantry school, administered by an unidentified officer with the rank of lieutenant colonel, is located at Sarajevo.
2. Courses conducted at the school are for a period of one year.
3. The school is organized in four battalions; each battalion includes three companies, each company having 50 men.
4. Two of the four battalions receive infantry training; another is made up of escort armament, and the fourth is motorized infantry.
5. On 6 May 1950 the military-political school of the Nis district began instruction of a new class. The course of instruction will be of six months' duration.
6. Staff personnel of the Nis district military-political school includes: Lt. General Radovan, commandant of the Nis district; Colonel Milenko Marojevic, Chief of Political Administration; and Lt. Colonel Bogdan Savicevic, Chief of the Recruiting Section. These are in addition to 16 instructors and 8 assistants.
