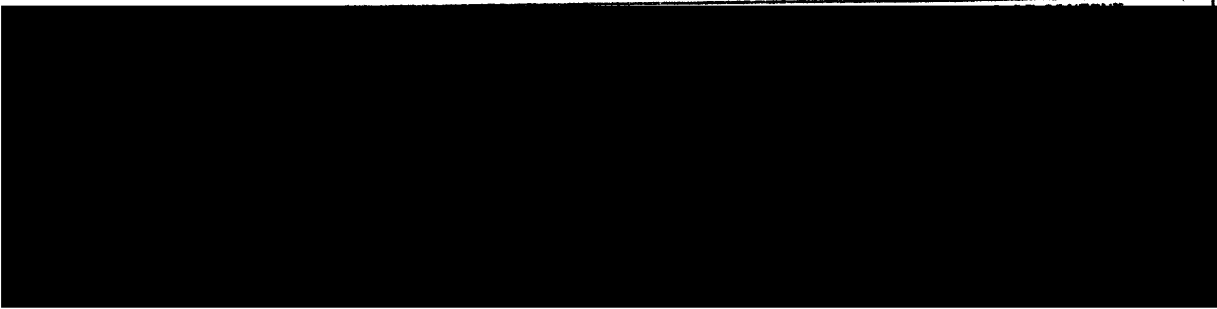

2. Chinese Communists in Cebu who are suspected of having been implicated in the murders of ENG Kee Go-tao and LIM Tian-teng are Jose LIM, GO Chai-seng, SIAO Yek-long, TAN Ni-pin, YU Yap-bin, GO Tak, and UY Ti-shun, all of whom have left Cebu for Manila or elsewhere in the Philippines.
3. The largest known Chinese Communist headquarters in the Southern Philippines is in Basay, Samar. There are 50 individuals attached to this headquarters, including those living in Tacloban, under the leadership of TY Sun-fok. Maasin, Leyte, also has a number of Chinese Communists. The former Secretary General of the Philippine Chinese Communist Party is active in Calbayog, Samar.
