1. In early July Soviet troops were observed in almost every major town along the railroad line from Frankfurt on the Oder via Posen (Poznań) to Brest-Litovsk. This fact was particularly noticeable because no Soviet troops had previously been observed in most of these towns.\*
2. No accumulations of weapons or of rolling stock were observed.

\* Comment: In early June there were about 200 Soviet soldiers in Kutno; and in late June there were 300-400 in Łódź.
