Chinese Communist troops are deployed along the Canton-Kowloon railroad as follows:

- a. About 1,200 troops of the 130 Division, commanded by TENG Shih-cheh (sic)*, are stationed at Shihlung (113-51, 23-07), along with 154 horses, 4 artillery units and 5 cannon.
- b. One thousand six hundred troops of the 388 Battalion are stationed in Shektan** and Chengkuo to deal with guerrillas along the railroad.
- c. The 389 Battalion has its headquarters at Lungkuan (113-46, 23-02); 500 troops are stationed at Changmoutao and 600 at Kushu and Nantao.
