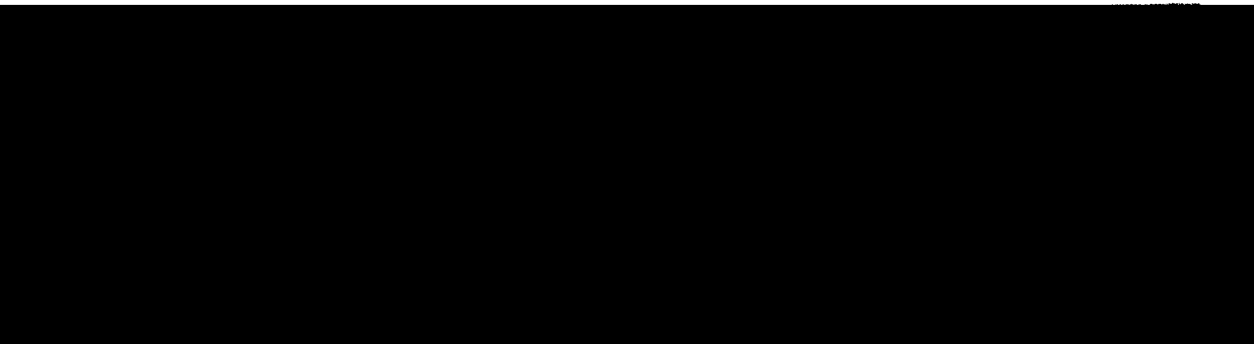

Subject: Authority.

### LETTER OF AUTHORITY

- A. Because of the present very tense situation in our fatherland, Indonesia, which is raped by Dutch Colonialism, it is now necessary to erect an organization for the purpose of unifying the people so that we may oppose Dutch Colonialism at every chance and in every way in Indonesia.
- B. After due consideration we have decided that Mr. Hadji Hakim will erect one (1) organization of the people or the youth, which will at every time and according to the command fulfill the duty of GRS to attain the ideals of a free and sovereign Indonesia (always Republican).
- C. Furthermore to be responsible in the district of Sungei Sidjenggi and environs. NOTE: This was given out as of 11 November 1949 at 8:00 AM official time
