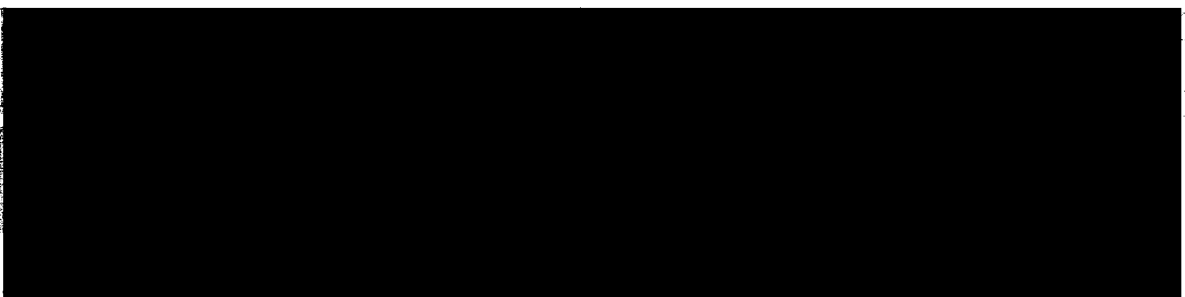

1. Instructions received by the Polish consulate in Rio de Janeiro from the Polish Foreign Office in Warsaw, effective 1 May 1950, provide that no Polish consulate abroad shall issue passports or visas to any person, whether he be businessman, immigrant, or visitor. Each consulate is to send all applications to Warsaw for its approval.
2. Current personal information on applicants is seldom desired by Warsaw, since it appears that personnel files are maintained in Poland. This is true even of those individuals who have not registered with the local consulate.
