1. The Flak Kaserne on Geusaerstrasse was occupied only by a small rear detail. No training activity was observed. Motor vehicle [REDACTED] were identified. \*

Weissenfels (M 52/J 99)

2. A rear unit of 50 to 70 men wearing black-bordered red epaulets was located in the barracks on the northern side of Selauerstrasse. [REDACTED] was identified in the barracks area.
3. A guard unit of about 50 men wearing red-bordered black epaulets was quartered in the Pionier Kaserne on the south side of Selauerstrasse on 21 June 1950. \*\*
4. The sentry in front of the kommandatura on Thornerstrasse wore red-bordered black epaulets. The kommandatura had moved to Thornerstrasse from the Rasalskistrasse some time ago.

5. A rear unit of 70 men wearing black-bordered red epaulets was seen in the Infanterie Kaserne on the north side of Selauerstrasse on 27 June 1950. [REDACTED] was identified there.
6. The houses on both sides of Jungstrasse, which had been occupied by Soviet officers' dependents, were vacant.
7. Only a few soldiers were seen in the barracks on the southern
