1. LI Shih (李石), a native of Ch'aochou (116-37, 23-42), is a Communist political instructor in Dr. K'IO Lin's Ching Hu Hospital in Macao. He is a representative of the Canton Military Control Commission (MCC)* and was appointed by the South China bureau*. With three assistants he conducts an indoctrination class in the hospital. He submits a daily report to the South China bureau and the Canton MCC. No person can be employed by the hospital without his approval.
2. LIN Ching-fang** is a female political instructor assigned to the Ching Hu Hospital by the Canton Women's Welfare Association*, and is a member of the nursing staff.
3. CHOU Han-ling*** was recently given the title of Vice Chairman of the Pearl River Delta Bandit Suppression Commission by YEH Chien-ying. He was sent to Hong Kong and Macao to persuade his former subordinates and the gang leaders with whom he has contacts to go to Canton and work for the Chinese Communists. While in Macao CHOU stayed at the home of YEN Hsien-chou (嚴仙舟), 26 Tak Shing Road. He had little success in his mission, for no one had much confidence in him. An exception was WU Ping (伍火丙), who consented to make contacts for CHOU.
