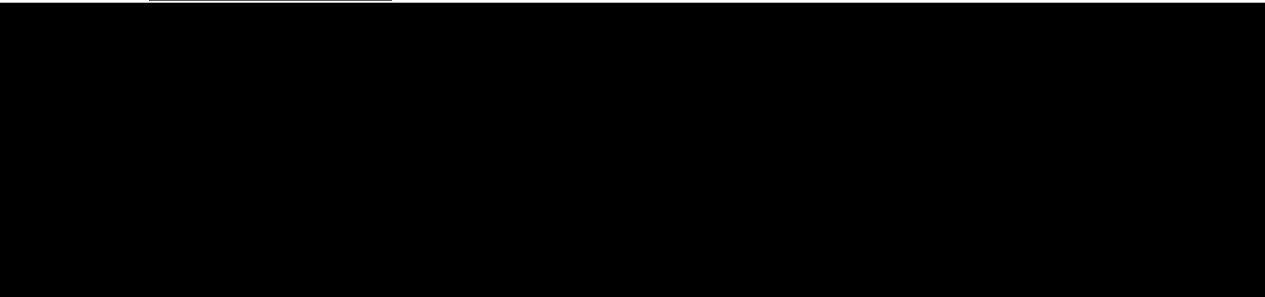

1. During the afternoon of 4 July 1950, three Soviet naval craft, reported as cruisers, arrived at the naval base area of Swinoujscie harbor. One vessel was described as having three smokestacks and the other two each. Many anti-aircraft batteries were observed on board each vessel. All vessels departed from Swinoujscie during the night of 8 July 1950.
2. An unusual number of motor torpedo boats and minelayer was observed in the Swinoujscie area during the period 3 July - 9 July 1950. Exercises were being held farther out at sea.
3. In early July, the Soviet naval installation was strengthened by the addition of six motor torpedo boats, with full crews numbering about 70 officers and men.
4. On 6 and 10 July, two Soviet jet aircraft were observed over Swinoujscie. In each case the aircraft arrived from the east and disappeared in the direction of Rügen Island.
