- imming the afternoon of 4 July 1950, three Soviet aval craft, reported as
 - ermisors, arrived at the naval base area of Swinoujuin harbor. One vessel was described as having three smokestacks and the ones two each. Many antiaircraft batteries were observed on board each vesse. All vessels departed from Swinoujscie during the night of 8 July 1950.
