Entertainment funds for the delegation of three members of the International Confederation of Free Trade Unions, who visited Taiwan on 21 and 22 July, were provided by the Taiwan Provincial Government to the host unions, the Chinese Federation of Labor, the Taiwan Federation of Labor, and the Free China Labor League. A total of 25,000 Yuan, Taiwan currency, half the amount originally asked for, was turned over to the Chinese Federation of Labor for distribution to the various labor unions that the delegates expected to visit during their tour of inspection.
2. Three members of the Chinese Federation of Labor, AN Fu-ting (安輔庭), a director of the Federation, MA Chao-chun*, and LI Ting-chen (李廷鏡), a former chairman of the Nanking General Labor Union, handled the funds. Before the delegation left, these men informed the Free China Labor League that the funds had run out, and the League spent an additional 2,000 Yuan, Taiwan currency, for entertaining the delegates on 22 July 1950.
