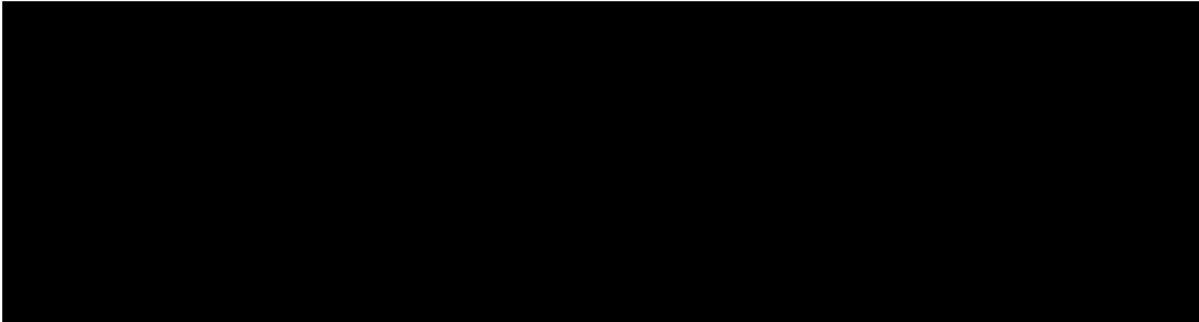

1. In spite of the many rumors on the subject, there is no evidence that any railroad lines in Hungary have been converted to the Russian broad gauge.
2. Direct trains continue to run to all the adjacent countries with the exception of the Soviet Union, and the only place where it is necessary to change trains is Csap (Chop), on the Soviet border.

Comment: Thus it is clear that the main lines have not been changed; until they have been converted, it would not be feasible to convert the branch lines.
