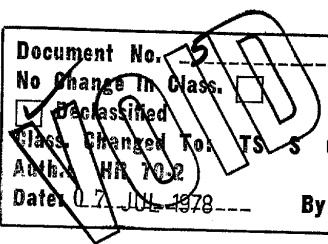

1. The information on close proximity fuses is based on the behavior of the shells. The premature explosion of the shells clearing the hill tops indicates that close proximity fuses are being used by untrained artillery men.
2. Although no duds have yet been obtained, the large amounts of ammunition captured from American forces early in the Korean war make it possible that these shells are U.S.-made.
