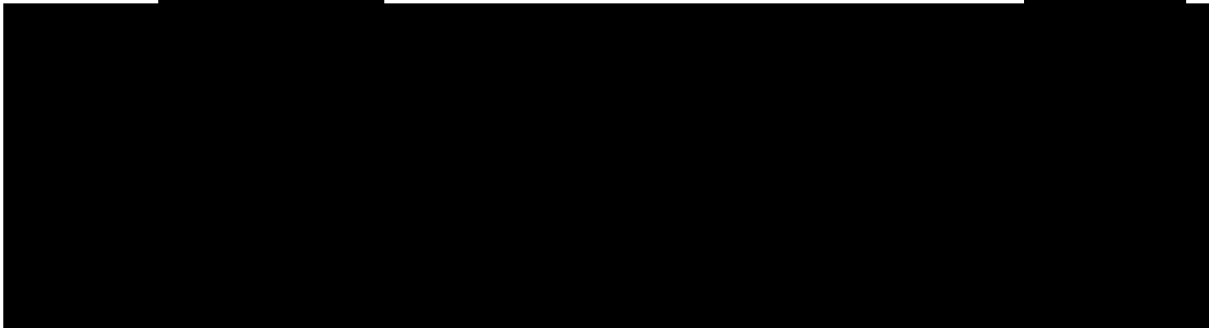

- 1. Relations between USIA's Central Commercial Bureau and "Intrac" Gesellschaft fuer Internationalen Warenaustausch und Grosshandel m.b.H., Communist export-import firm in Vienna, have somewhat deteriorated since Smurushenkov assumed Shevchenko's former job as director general of this USIA office. (1) Perhaps one reason for this is that Smurushenkov is now trying to persuade Tikhomirov, Soviet Director General of USIA, to designate the Central Commercial Bureau as the final authority on all USIA transactions. If Tikhomirov sanctions Smurushenkov's plans, USIA firms will be required to clear all of their business dealings with the Satellites, Intrac and other non-USIA firms through the Central Commercial Bureau.
- 2. Meanwhile the Central Commercial Bureau is pressing Intrac for payment of a fairly large debt which it has incurred with this USIA office. In this connection USIA employees have heard that Intrac is in serious financial straits, allegedly because it has lost money on a number of transactions with Hungary, namely compensation agreements involving the exchange of USIA electrical equipment for Hungarian meat and lard products.
