1. [Redacted] the deputy chief of the Soviet Mission in Peiping arrived in Canton from Hankow, accompanied by the Soviet adviser to the 4 Field Army and two executives of the Central and South China Military and Political Commission.

3. Although the deputy chief's tour of inspection was originally planned to include a visit to Hainan and the Indochina border, he returned to Peiping by train [Redacted] to attend an important military conference scheduled to open there [Redacted] 50X1-HUM
